



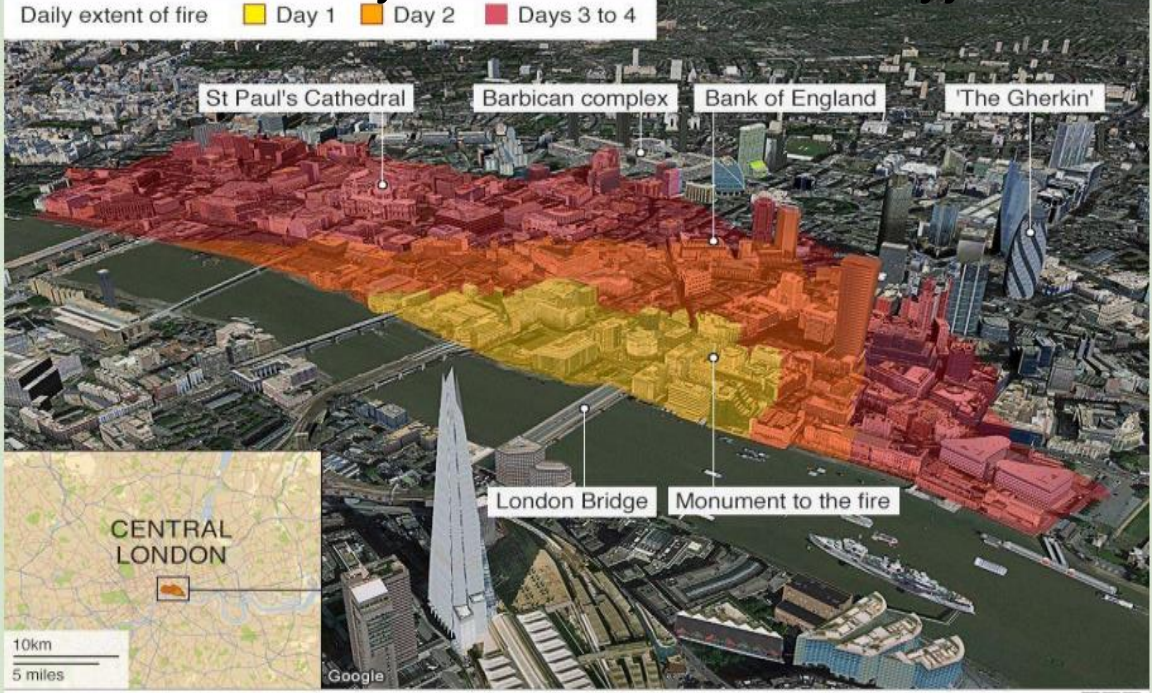

The fire started in Pudding Lane, in Thomas Farriner's bakery.

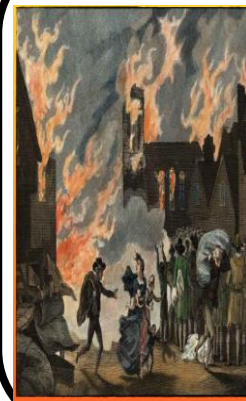

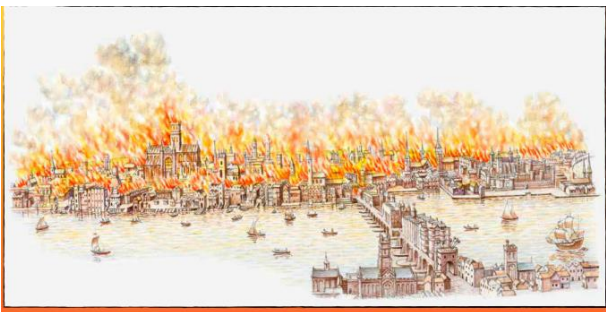


King Charles II

The fire spread so quickly, Samuel Pepys was woken up. At 10am, King Charles said they should start pulling houses down to stop the fire spreading. Pepys went to tell the mayor then went home for lunch.



After lunch, Pepys went to the cathedral and saw people with their belongings.. He hid his money box to keep it safe. The wind was blowing and now lots of London was on fire.



Over the next few days, the flames lit the sky and the cathedral had set on fire. Pepys kept going back to check on things. The fire was eventually put out by 7th September, 1666.
