### Parking and Driving Outside School

Once again we are finding ourselves asking parents to take care and be more considerate when dropping off and collecting children in cars, and parking and driving outside the school site. We kindly ask parents not to :

- Do 3 point turns out on Green Park Avenue in the area right outside school : we have had a couple of near misses where children have not been seen as cars are reversing
- Park in front of the school car park gates when they are closed : this entrance is needed at all times for safe access and also so families walking past can be seen and be safe
- Drive at any speed along the road : this puts children and families at risk, and in the awful scenario of an accident happening, there is far more chance of a child surviving being hit by a car that is moving slowly.
- Park on, or drive up on the kerbs : the pavements are always busy with families coming to or leaving school and this puts them at risk. It also makes it extremely hard for parents with buggies and many end up walking in a busy road with children and buggies.
- Park in the bus lay by when teachers have messaged that a trip is returning and the coach needs a safe place to park: During a recent trip, the returning coach blocked the road stopping access for everyone along Green Park Avenue as it had no-where to park. More importantly the children had get off the coach straight into the busy road, and had to move in between parked cars to get safely on to the pavement.

Whilst we totally understand that parking is an issue on Green Park Avenue, we do not have any responsibility for this and we do complain to the council as much as we know you do. However as a community I know you will join us in trying to do as much as we can to safeguard our children and families, so we appeal to you all to help us to do this in a kind and thoughtful way. We all want our children to stay safe!

### Collection and Passwords

Thank you for your patience whilst we have been ironing out any initial issues with our new password/ collection system. It is proving an effective way of ironing out confusions over collections. So please remember – if you ask anyone other than yourselves to collect your child from school please make sure you also give them the password!
