



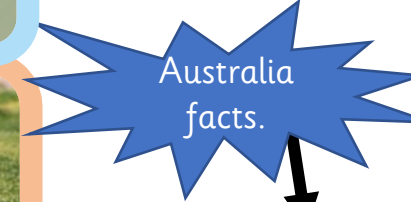
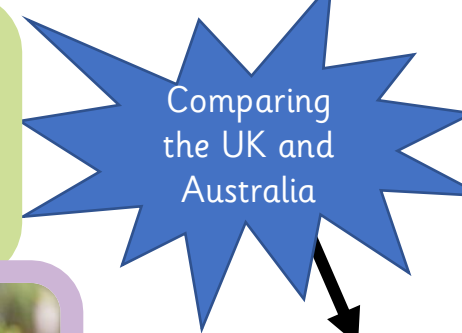
Vocabulary	Definition

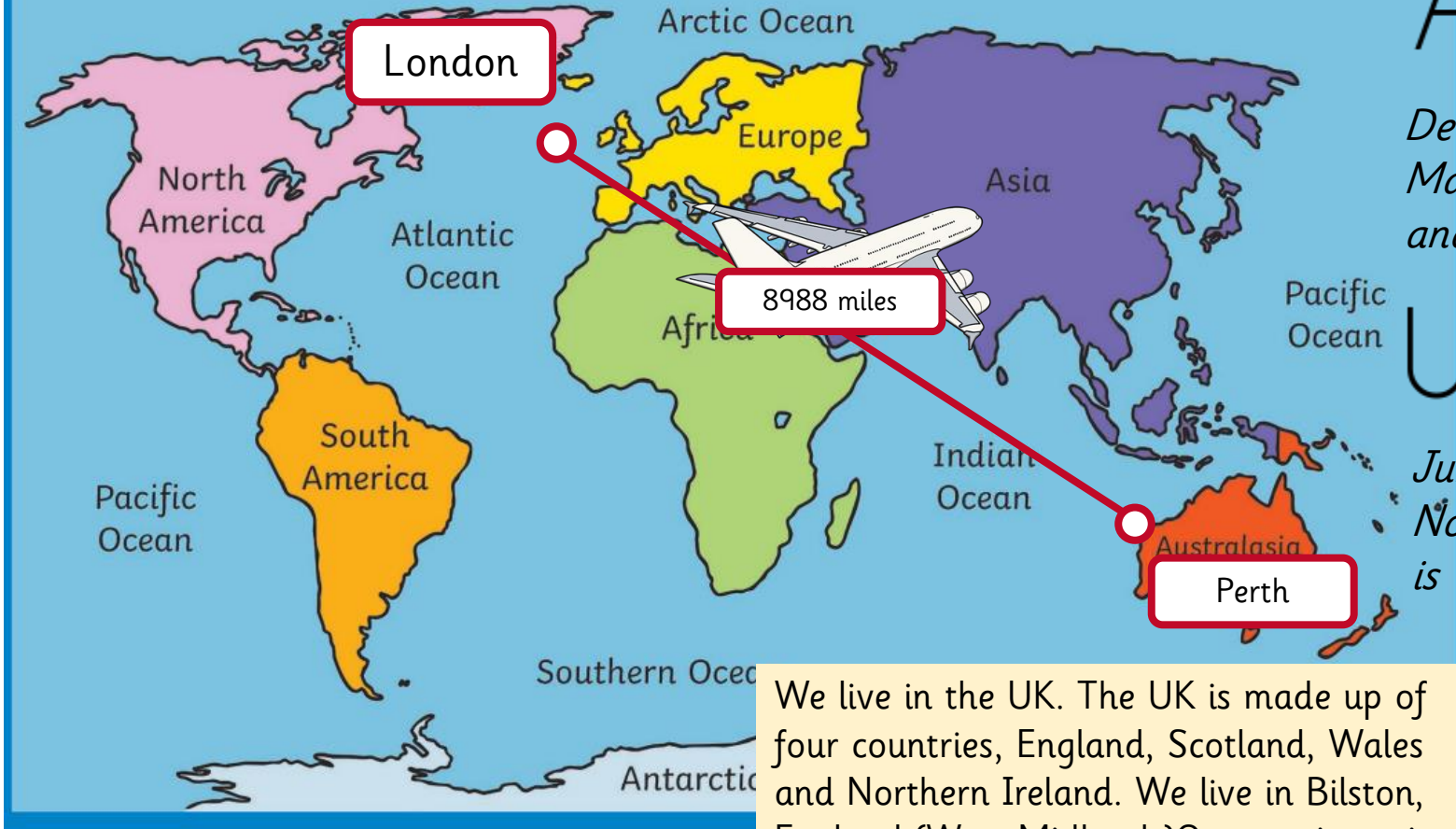
