Key Vocabulary	Definition
County	A region of a country which has its own local government and communities.
Delta	Wetlands that form when rivers meet other bodies of water (such as oceans)
Tributary	A small stream or river which branches off from a larger river
Human Geography	Geographical features which are made by humans, like buildings
Faulting	Fracturing in the rock of the earth
Erosion	When earth wears away due to weather conditions
Altitude	The height between ground level and the top of a hill/mountain
