

Overview:

We will learn about Textiles and Fabrics and how they cam be joined together to make a stuffed animal toy.

We will investigate fabrics to find the most suitable. We will explore fastening techniques and learn how to use templates to make matching parts.

In guided groups we will look at running stitch, threading needles, stapling, lacing and gluing. We will explore finishing techniques such as sewing buttons, 3-D fabric paint, gluing sequins, printing.

Clothes, curtains, rugs, towels and toys are all made from different textiles. They are made in factories or mills.


Weaving Knitting Crocheting


Different textiles


Making and Decorating
