Our 8 week half term is now coming to an end and we have packed so much into the time we have been back in school! Everyone has settled well into their learning, including our newest members of the school family in Nursery and Reception classes. We would like to thank all of you who were able to visit your child's classes after school last Wednesday — it was lovely to see the classes so full of children and families sharing in their learning.

We are making some important changes to the collection of children at the end of school – including introducing a password system so there is no confusion when children are collected. You can find more information below but please look out for a new form arriving by the end of this week on Parentmail.

You will see on the school calendar that lots more events and activities have been added throughout the year. To help you plan in advance for the costs of trips and visits, I have also attached an overview of the year with trips booked with a cost – or trips that year groups are hoping to take place. As a school we pay for all coach travel for the children, and we ask you to pay the amount for entry fees and / or associated workshops. This often works out to a 50/50 split between school and yourselves for each trip. We hope that this means no child will miss out on a trip due to financial barriers. However, if you do need support with this, or any other matter please do not hesitate to contact us.

We hope you all have a safe and happy half term, whether you are celebrating Diwali, Halloween, Bonfire Night or just having a rest! We look forward to seeing you all back in school Monday 4th November.

Parent Collection Safequarding Information

This week all parents will be receiving a form via Parentmail where you will be asked details about dropping off and collecting your children. We have lots of pieces of information in different places so we want to collate it all in an easier way for both yourselves and the staff. We are also asking you to choose a password that anyone who we are not sure should be collecting your child MUST tell us. We are introducing this as an extra safeguarding measure as we still have occasions where someone is sent to collect a child who is unknown to us, and we have not been notified either.

This password will stay the same for your child through their time at Stowlawn but **PLEASE** make sure that everyone who collects your child knows your child's password — whether they are on the named collection list or an emergency collector! If you need to change this password for any reason then please see the school office. We are asking that you complete the information on the Parentmail App by FRIDAY 1st NOVEMBER. We will let you know when all the information has been collated and when the passwords will be needed for collection.

Inclusive Attendance Update

Over the last couple of weeks our Phase leaders have been looking at children's attendance, and you may have been contacted to see if we can offer support to help your child further to come into school and/ or be here on time. In the first week back after half term, we will be sending out your child's attendance report for this half term so you can keep track as we move through the year.

Dates for your diary: We are running a couple of parents workshops next term where we will share our new attendance policy, and share our thoughts around attendance, as well as seeking "parent voice" around our policies and practice. These will run on the afternoons of Monday 18th November and Tuesday 19th November. Further details will be sent out after half term.

Holidays and Leave of Absence During Term Time

As supportive as we can be with your children's day to day attendance, I also want to remind you that legally we have to follow the guidelines published by the government in terms of leave of absence during term time. All holiday requests/ leave of absence will be unauthorised by the school so this is a fair policy for everyone. We have to inform the LA of any holiday/ leave of absence for 5 or more days and they will decide whether to issue a fine. Fines are not issued by or paid to the school. I know it can be a difficult decision for parents to take children out of school for an extended time, and as a school we do understand the different reasons why you may choose to do so. However the policy has to be applied fairly, so please think carefully as if fines are issued, they can be very costly to families. For example, if a family has 2 children here in school, they can be fined £120 per parent per child for a holiday taken in term time. This would result in a fine being issued for £480.
